
Living in the midwest the winters can be quite harsh and teetering. If a few small thing can save homeowners money then it doesn't hurt to do so.



As harvesting season is in full affect, the ARC plan has been a common point of conversation for the major losses many have faced.

"The ARC-CO program provides income support tied to historical base acres, not current production, of covered commodities. ARC-CO payments are issued when the actual county crop revenue of a covered commodity is less than the ARC-CO guarantee for the covered commodity." Is how ARC payments are defined by the RMA.
